Study Question 1

- As is the custom of the master, he tells us that he comes for a specific purpose and to perform a specific action.
- What did he tell the people of Chicago? (p. 293)

Study Question 2

- Beloved Victory had the support of the LORD to enter the city of Chicago.
 - What direction did the LORD give to Victory? (p. 293)
- Note:** When the word Lord is capitalized, the capitalized LORD stands for I AM THAT I AM or the I AM Presence.

Study Question 3

- What magnificent dispensation did the master announce to those in attendance? (p. 293)
- Please create a call from this dispensation and include this call in your daily decrees.

Study Question 4

- Beloved Victory cried as the LORD God and Archangel Michael cried over earth's

conditions. In response to their lamentations, an angel stepped forward and spoke. (p. 293)

- Which angel stepped forward and what did the angel say? (p. 293)

Study Question 5

- The master communicated a vision and an action taken in the past by the current generation of lightbearers. What did the master say to them? (p. 294)

Study Question 6

- Beloved Victory asks us to receive the inverting of the Great Divine Director's rod of power. (p. 294)
- What grace is released through this act of inversion? (p. 294)

Study Question 7

- The master enlightens us on the two types of victory. He said:

“There is a victory of the flesh. There is the victory of the spirit. One enters the other, and the soul who is the bride of Christ does enter the transfiguration of her Lord.” (p. 294)

- Then Victory delivered a dispensation to our soul. What dispensation did we receive? (p. 294)

Study Question 8

- Beloved Victory reminds us:

“Beloved, the hour of victory is that for which you have been prepared and for which you have prepared yourselves diligently. And yet you have reached the ceiling of the offerings of Church and State—the politicians, the economists, and the wolves in sheep's clothing everywhere apparent and nonapparent yet most transparent to us....” (p. 294)

- What reasons does the master give for the ceiling of the offerings of Church and State? (pp. 294-295)
- What tragic outcome did the master identify in leadership due to the lack of divine solutions? (p. 295)

Study Question 9

- What antidote does Victory ascribe for the ineffectiveness of human solutions? (p. 295)

Study Question 10

- As a “torch bearer of an age,” what questions does Victory pose to you? (p. 297)
- What is your response to each of his questions? Record your responses in your Victory Journal.

Study Question 11

- How does Victory describe the “spiritual man?” (p. 296)

Study Question 12

- The master tells us that it is not uncommon for the energies of anti-victory to surface as depression, defeatism, and cynicism in the presence of the angels of victory. When these energies of anti-victory surface, what course of action faces us? (pp. 296-297)
- Record in your Victory Journal the action you will take when you observe yourself expressing the consciousness of anti-victory.

Study Question 13

- The master further impresses upon our soul the path to Victory.

“Understand that anti-victory as defeatism must be defeated *by you* within yourself, within the mind and the subconscious, by an act of will and a decision that says, ‘I can do all things through God, who strengthens me.’ There is not victory without him. And in him you live and he in thee, beloved.” (p. 297)

- Please post the words, “I can do all things through God, who strengthens me” somewhere that you are able to view them daily. Then begin your day and by reciting “I can do all things through God, who strengthens me.”

Study Question 14

- Victory asks us to surrender one idea. What idea did he ask us to surrender? (p. 297)

Study Question 15

- In this dictation the master reminds us, “Remember the key word of the Son of God.” (p. 297)
- Why did he include this reminder in his address? (p. 297)
- Identify the key word and write it in your Victory Journal. (p. 297)

Study Question 16

- Beloved Victory admonishes us not to fall for the fallacy that he or other ascended masters are responsible for earth’s victory.

“Beloved, you are in the world, not I. You cannot say that Mighty Victory is the light of the world. But you can say, ‘I am the spirit of Mighty Victory incarnate! And the I

AM THAT I AM of me *is* the light of victory in the earth.” (p. 297)
