As we prepare for this summer's annual Summit University seminar, we wanted to inform you of the onsite attendance guidelines. Due to limited staffing, we can only receive 150 English- and Spanish-speaking students on site for this summer's SU seminar.

The good news is that we have lifted the quarantine for domestic travelers. The following information will explain the restrictions and guidelines that will be in effect for the seminar. Regardless of whether we see you in person or online this summer, the SU Team looks forward to welcoming you to the SU classroom on Tuesday, July 6!

I. General Information:

- a. **Seminar:** The seminar will be offered in King Arthur's Court (KAC) in English and Spanish and will be broadcast worldwide in English, Spanish and Portuguese. No Russian translations will be available.
- b. **Meals:** Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served daily during the seminar with precautions based on industry best practices.
- c. **Bookstore:** The bookstore will be open to seminar attendees during some meal breaks. Patrons are encouraged to use of face coverings and to social distance while shopping.
- d. **Housing:** We regret that we cannot offer onsite housing for this seminar. Camping spaces and RV parking will be available through Yellowstone Hot Springs at East Gate. Other accommodations are available in Gardiner, MT. Make reservations early as these spaces are in high demand.

- e. **Daily Shuttle Service:** At this time, we cannot offer a daily shuttle service for SU students staying at East Gate, Gardiner or Glastonbury.

- f. **Airport Shuttle Service:** Airport shuttle service to/from the Bozeman Airport will not be available for SU students this summer. Rental cars are available at Bozeman Airport—make your reservations early as this is the busiest time of year.

II. Attending In-Person & COVID 19 Requirements

- a. **Attendance:** Due to limited staffing, attendance is restricted to 150 students and is open only to “Members.” That means Keepers of the Flame in good standing are welcome to attend in person. Pre-registration is encouraged.
- b. **Onsite Translations:** Due to limited staffing, onsite attendance is limited to English and Spanish students only. Portuguese students are encouraged to join the virtual broadcast for the seminar.
- c. **Temperature check daily:** Upon arrival each day, personnel will take your temperature and ask if you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19.
- d. **Masks:** These are not required and remain a personal preference for attendees.

III. Attending Virtually:

- a. **Virtual registration:** Students who register for the virtual seminar option will receive detailed instructions via email in June regarding how to access their workbook and daily broadcast link.
- b. **Languages:** The seminar will be broadcast in English, Spanish and Portuguese.
- c. **Regional re-broadcasts:** The seminar will be re-broadcast to the Europe/Africa and Asia/Pacific regions on July 7-10 via Zoom. Details for connecting to these Zoom broadcasts will be available to students who register for one of these options.

IV. Out-of-State U.S. versus International

- a. **Quarantine:** No quarantine period is required for U.S. visitors from out of state. For international visitors, see following pages for testing and quarantine requirements.
- b. While we will take every precaution to keep everyone safe, please understand that given the nature of the virus, we cannot offer any guarantees, and attendance is at your own risk. If you are in the category of people who are at higher risk of complications due to age or pre-existing health conditions, we recommend that you do not attend in person and join us on the broadcast instead.

V. General Inner Retreat Attendance Guidelines

For everyone’s safety, please do not come to the Inner Retreat or your local Teaching Center or Study Group if you or anyone in your household:

- 1) Has been diagnosed with the virus and has not met the criteria for when it is safe to be around others,
- 2) Has symptoms of the virus,

- 3) Is waiting for viral test results,
- 4) Are known to have been in “close contact” with a person who has tested positive for the virus in the last 10 days, unless you have documentation of immunity, which could include documentation of infection in the past and recovery,
- 5) Is at increased risk of severe illness from the virus.

VI. International Visitors Travel Requirements

If you plan on traveling to the Inner Retreat from outside the United States, we ask that you fulfill **ONE** of the following precautionary requirements:

- 1) Quarantine for a minimum of 10 days.
- 2) The quarantine may be reduced to 7 days after travel if you have a negative PCR test result 3-5 days after your arrival in the United States.
- 3) Provide documentation of immunity, which could include documentation of infection in the past and recovery.
